COURSE DESCRIPTION

All cohorts will meet Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday for 3 weeks, for 35 minutes per session.

Week 1: Phonics/Decoding

During Week 1, our expert instructors will help your child develop strong phonics and decoding skills, laying the foundation for a lifetime of reading success. With interactive games, engaging activities, and plenty of one-on-one attention, your child will be well on their way to becoming a confident and skilled reader.

Week 2: Reading - Story Elements

In Week 2, we'll dive into the exciting world of story elements. Your child will explore the key elements of a good story, from setting and character development to plot and conflict resolution. By the end of the week, they'll have a deep understanding of what makes a great story, and they'll be eager to put their newfound knowledge to use.

Week 3: Reading - Vocabulary/Decoding

And in Week 3, we'll turn our focus to vocabulary and decoding. Your child will learn new words and phrases, expanding their language skills and building their confidence as they tackle more challenging texts. They'll also develop a deeper understanding of the mechanics of reading, from recognizing common sight words to using context clues to decipher unfamiliar words.
